



RVFF FIREFIGHTER CANCER RELIEF Guidelines & Application

1. The applicant must be an active fire/EMS provider with at least three years of fire suppression activities from one of the RVFF covered localities (Roanoke City, Salem City, Roanoke County, Franklin County, Botetourt County, or Bedford County).
2. Volunteer rescue squad personnel are NOT covered under the Cancer Relief Program, as they are excluded from VA LODA cancer presumptive status.
3. The RVFF Firefighter Cancer Relief Program covers ALL cancers for eligible personnel, not just the seven named in the VA LODA presumptive cancer status. This includes testicular, colon, melanoma, and glioblastoma (brain) cancer.
4. The applicant must be in the **treatment phase** of their cancer to receive aid.
5. The applicant may only apply for relief from the fund ONE time with a maximum emergency grant of \$1000.00 awarded. The applicant may apply for either medical or living expenses to be covered, and payment will be made to the **provider**, not the applicant.
6. An invoice or bill must be provided to the Roanoke Valley Firefighters Foundation in the applicant's name for the invoice to be paid.
7. All information submitted on the application is considered to be **CONFIDENTIAL** and will remain private. No discussion of applicant names or medical condition will be discussed outside of the RVFF Board of Directors.
